Quinquennial Agricultural Census 2021-22: An Overview

1. Introduction

The Agriculture Census forms part of a broader system of collection of agricultural statistics. It is a large scale statistical operation for the collection and derivation of quantitative information about the structural aspects of agriculture in the State. An agricultural operational holding is the most disaggregated unit for taking decisions related to agricultural development at the micro level. It is for this reason that an operational holding is taken as the statistical unit for data collection and for describing the structure of agriculture. Through the agriculture census, the state endeavours to collect basic data on all the important aspects of the agricultural economy for all the operational holdings in the country. Aggregation of data is done at various levels of administrative units (Villages, Mandal, District & State).

Periodic agriculture censuses are important, as they are the main source of information on basic characteristics of operational holdings such as land use and cropping pattern, irrigation status, tenancy particulars and the terms of leasing. This information is tabulated by different size classes and social groups including scheduled castes/ scheduled tribes which are needed for development planning, socio-economic policy formulation and establishment of national priorities. The census also provides the basis for the development of a comprehensive, integrated national system of agricultural statistics, and has links with various components of the national statistical system. The whole project of agriculture census in the country is implemented in three distinct phases, which are statistically linked together, but focus on different aspects of agricultural statistics.

Phase-I of the Agriculture Census covered from village land records of the state on primary characteristics like number of operational holdings and area operated by different size classes (Marginal, Small, Semi-medium, Medium and Large), social groups (SC, ST, Others), gender (Male/Female/Transgender), type of holding (Individual, Joint and Institutional). In 11th Agriculture Census the State were covered total (10654) villages among 595 mandals of 32 districts (except Hyderabad). Out of (10654) villages, Table 1 prepared for (10639) villages, remaining (15) villages have not been covered due to Urbanization, Forest, Submerged and Un-inhabited villages, etc.

Phase-II of the Census, operational holding schedule is canvassed in selected 20 percent villages in each mandal for collecting detailed data on characteristics of operational holdings such as land use, irrigation status, cropping pattern, etc.

Phase – III of the Census, popularly known as the Input Survey, relates to collection of data on the pattern of input use by operational holdings. This survey is conducted in 7 percent of the villages selected in each Mandal of the State. Thus, the whole operation of the Agriculture Census is a combination of census and sample surveys, which reflect the entirety of each characteristics of agricultural operational holding.

The Agriculture Census is conducted following broad guidelines for the decennial World Census of Agriculture conducted by the Food and Agriculture Organization of UN. Telangana has been participating in the World Agriculture Census programme for more than four decades. The first State-wide comprehensive agriculture census was conducted in 1970-71 (1st July 1970 to 30th June, 1971) as the reference period as part of the 1970 World Agriculture Census. Subsequently agriculture censuses were conducted in the state during 1976-77, 1980-81, 1985-86, 1990-91, 1995-96, 2000-01, 2005-06, 2010-11 and 2015-16. The present 11th agriculture census in the series has been conducted with 2021-22 (1st July, 2021 to 30th June, 2022) as the reference period. .

2. Objectives

The main objectives of the agriculture census are:

- i. To describe the structure and characteristics of agriculture by providing statistical data on operational holdings, including land utilization, live-stock, agricultural machinery and implements, use of fertilizers etc.
- ii. To provide benchmark data needed for formulating new agricultural development programmes and for evaluating their progress.
- iii. To provide statistical frame of operational holdings for carrying out future agricultural surveys and
- iv. To lay the foundation for developing an integrated programme for current agricultural statistics.

3. New Initiatives in Agriculture Census 2021-22

To improve the quality and reliability of data, and reduce the time lag in publication of results, new initiatives introduced in Agriculture Census 2021-22 are as under:

1. Use of digitized land records.
2. Collection of data through app/software using hand-held devices like smartphones.
3. Complete enumeration of all villages in Phase-I.
4. Collection of new data items on ownership & tenancy status in Phase I.
5. Different reference period for each Phase.
6. Dissemination of data for Phase-I at village level.
7. Real-time monitoring of progress and uploading/downloading of data/software through web portal

4. Reference Year

For the Agriculture Census the reference periods for collection of data in Phases-I, II & III are as under:

Note: Phase-I of the Census has been completed within the time schedule. The Ministry of Agriculture has also appreciated the efforts of the Telangana State Government in this regard.

5. Methodology

The data on the number and area of operational holdings according to different size-classes, social groups and gender wise would be collected and compiled on through re-tabulation of information available in the village land records. This entails covering all the survey numbers in each village and preparing a list of 'Operational Holdings' therefrom. An Operational Holding is the basic unit of enumeration.

The unit for collection of data is the holding of the actual cultivator, and not the owner. Some holdings may not be located completely within a single village, but spread over more than one village. For preparation of a list of operational holdings, necessary integration of the part-holdings scattered over more than one village is done. A holding may cut across the boundary of a Village / Mandal / District / State. The Mandal is considered the outer limit for pooling of all parcels of an operational holding. If a holding is spread over more than one Mandal, that part of the holding which lies outside the Mandal of residence of the operational holder is treated as a separate operational holding.

Part-holdings are pooled in the village where operational holder resides. Necessary pooling of the part holdings is done before preparation of Table-1 for the village. Once Table-1 is prepared, part holdings would have been fully accounted for and the list of operational holdings of a village will be those belonging to the resident cultivators.

Collection of data, namely (i) distribution of holdings according to tenancy status; (ii) area under different land uses; (iii) distribution of holdings according to irrigation status; (iv) area under horticulture and other than horticulture crops for 20 percent of total villages i.e., the villages selected randomly under Timely Reporting of Agriculture Statistics scheme for the reference year of the census. This information is compiled from the basic village Land records.

6. Unique feature:

The Ministry of Agriculture, GOI has conducted the present 11th Agriculture census by using extraction method for all village wise land records data already computerized data to improve the quality and coverage of agricultural census also make it available timely in feature.

Concepts and Definitions

It is ensure before listing any operational holder, whether he has actually put his land, wholly or partly to agricultural production during the reference agricultural year. In case the operational holder has put his entire land to non-agricultural use during the reference year and has kept it fallow during the preceding year also, such holder will not qualify as an operational holder, and hence it was not listed. If the entire area is kept as current fallow in the reference year but some part of it was cultivated during the previous year, such area is treated as an operational holding. An operational holding would include both the cultivated and uncultivated land. If both net area sown and current fallow are zero during the reference year, such holding will not be considered as an operational holding although some area may exist in other part(s) of the classification of land use.

Operational Holding: All land which is used wholly or partly for agricultural production and is operated as one technical unit by one person alone or with others without regard to the title, legal form, size or location.

Operated area: Operated area includes both cultivated and uncultivated area, provided part of it is put to agricultural production during the reference period. If, for instance, an operational holding consists of four survey numbers out of which one survey number is put to non-agricultural uses, the total area of the operational holding will be equal to the total geographical area of all the four survey numbers.

It would also cover the land occupied by the farm buildings, including the house of the holder, provided such buildings are located within the operated area. If the farm buildings are located outside the cultivated area and are covered under abadi area, such buildings would not be included.

Operated area would exclude government forest land, government waste land, village common grazing land, abadi area etc. However, if Government waste land has been allotted to an individual for agriculture purpose, then it will also be included in the holding.

If the entire area of the holding (the area of all the survey numbers of an operational holding) is put to non-agricultural use and/ or it is under old fallow, it will not be considered as operated area. If, however, the entire area of operational holding is under current fallow during the reference year but was cultivated in the preceding year, this would still be considered as operational holding.

In some cases, land is divided amongst all the members of the family. Where it is divided between the husband, wife and minor children and the cultivation is being done by the husband as the head of the family, the land is appropriately treated as one operational holding.

There might be cases where in the records, a holding is shown jointly in the name of more than one co-sharer while in fact the land may have been privately divided and the co-sharers are independently cultivating. In such cases where there is no dispute, they are treated as many operational holdings as the number of independent cultivators. This is necessary because in agriculture census, the data is to be collected on the basis of defacto position rather than de jure position.

Some times name of three or four persons are shown. While from the records it would appear that there is only one holding, in practice, all the three or four brothers are actually cultivating the land independently of each other although there is no legal partition of land. From the census point of view, this would constitute three or four operational holdings.

For cultivated areas in the state forests, no detailed land records are prepared. In the absence of revenue records, such areas are excluded for census purposes.

The operated area comprise the following:

- Owned & self-operated
- Individual other than Owner but within the household
- Leased out
- Otherwise operated

Owned and self-operated: Land for which the cultivator has the right to permanent heritable possession is considered as owned. This includes land held from government or others under grant or lease or assignment with right of permanent heritable possession with or without right of transfer.

- Land operated under perpetual lease.

Self-operated land would include:

- Self cultivation.
- Land cultivated through members of the family
- Land cultivated with the help of hired labour. Land owned and self operated should not include land leased out to others.

Leased In: Area leased in is defined as land taken on lease from others without any permanent right of possession for the lessee. Land is leased in for

- Fixed money
- Fixed produce
- Share of produce
- Usufructuary mortgage
- Other terms specified.

Usufructuary mortgage: Ownership of the property remains with the mortgager but the possession is with the mortgagee (i.e., the person to whom the mortgage is made or given). Income from the property accrues to the mortgagee and the mortgage is terminated as soon as the full amount is realized.

Otherwise operated: This would include encroachment of land, land forcibly occupied, unauthorized or land in dispute etc., which is not treated as owned or leased in, as per the definitions given above.

Operational Holder: An operational holder is the person who has the responsibility for the operation of the agricultural holding and who exercises the technical initiative and is responsible for its operation. He/ she may have full economic responsibility or share it with others. The operational holder may be individual, joint or Institutional.

Individual holder: If the holding is operated either by one person alone or by a group of persons who are the members of the same household, it is considered as an individual holding.

Joint holder: If two or more persons belonging to different households, share jointly as partners in the economic and technical responsibility for the operation of an agricultural holding, such holding is considered as joint.

Institutional: Holdings such as government farms, sugarcane factory farms, cooperative farms, lands managed by trust is treated as Institutional.

Resident operational holder: All the cultivators residing in a particular village and cultivating some land within the same Mandal are resident cultivators of that village irrespective of whether they are cultivating land in that village or not. A resident cultivator may, therefore, have either (i) entire area of the holding located in the village of his residence or (ii) partly within the village of residence and partly outside; or (iii) entirely outside the village of residence.

Non-resident operational holder: An operational holder operating area outside the mandal in which his/her village of residence falls is not treated as a resident cultivator of the village of his residence for agriculture census purposes. He/she is treated as a resident cultivator of the village outside the mandal where the area falls.

If the area in a particular village is operated by a cultivator who resides outside that village but within the same mandal, he/she is a non-resident operational holder for that area.

However, if this operational holder is resident of a village lying outside the mandal in which the area is located, he/she is treated as a resident operational holder (deemed resident) of the village, where the area is located.

Complete/ Part-Holding: A holding is said to be complete holding if the entire operated area of that holding is located in one village. If the operated area is spread over more than one village, it is considered as part-holding. Mandal is taken as the outer limit for consolidation of part holdings.

Collection and computerization of data: Data on the number and area of operational holdings across all villages in the state, according to different size-classes of holdings, social groups, types of holdings and gender of operational holders i.e., Table-1, was collected and compiled on complete enumeration basis through an online web based software application developed by the NIELIT, Kolkata.

abadi: Residential area and non-agricultural area.

Highlights of Census of Land Holdings 2021-22

All holdings:

- The total number of operational holdings recorded in the state is 70,59,859 covering an area of 63,12,033.32 hectares.
- Increase of 18.70 percent of holdings as against 59,47,735 of 2015-16 census and 5.70 percent of area as against 59,71,814.11 lakh hectares of 2015-16.
- The average size of the holdings in the state was declined from 1.00 hectares in 2015-16 to 0.89 hectare in 2021-22.
- There has been increase in holdings and area operated by Marginal, Small size categories under all social groups by 26.22%, 13.56% holdings and in terms of area it is 21.16%, 13.17% respectively in the census 2021-22 over previous Census 2015-16.
- It is a decrease in the number of holdings and area operated by semi-medium, medium size categories under all social groups by 10.47%, 21.11% holdings and in terms of area it is 11.55%, 20.50 % respectively in the census 2021-22 over previous Census 2015-16. In large group decrease as 0.71 in holdings and area increased as 21.89.
- Individual holdings are 99.99 percent of total holdings with an operated area of 99.85 percent of total operated area.
- Male holdings constituted 67.21 percent of total holdings and cover 70.56 percent of the total operated area.
- The total number of holdings operated by females are 23,14,988

covering area of 18.49 lakh hectares and the share of percentage to total holdings is 32.79 and area is 29.29 respectively in 2021-22.

- There are 387 joint holdings which is 0.005 percent of total holdings with an operated area of 458.50 hectares representing 0.007 percent of the total operated area in 2021-22.

Scheduled Castes Holdings

- The total number of holdings operated by scheduled castes are 9,78,609 covering an area of 6,10,820.54 hectares and thereby showing increase of 39.80 percent in holdings and increase of 14.77 percent in area as against 2021-22 Census.
- There is a increase in the number of holdings and area operated by scheduled castes in size classes of Marginal, Small, Large. In Semi medium, Medium size classes decrease in number of holdings and area.
- The average size of the holdings operated by scheduled castes is 0.62 hectares as per 2021-22 Census as against 0.76 hectares recorded in 2015-16 Census.

Scheduled Tribes Holdings

- The total number of holdings operated by scheduled tribes are 8,33,718 covering an area of 7,53,289.41 hectares. An increase of 17.02 percent in the number and 1.71 percent in the area was noticed in the holdings held by scheduled tribes during this census against 2015-16 Census.
- The average size of the holdings operated by scheduled tribes in 2021-22 Agriculture Census is 0.90 hectares as against 1.04 hectares in Agriculture Census 2015-16.

Other Holdings (Other than Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes)

- The number of holdings and area operated by “other community” i.e. other than scheduled castes and scheduled tribes are 52,47,248 and 49,38,714.27 hectares respectively. An increase of 15.72 percent in the number and 5.22 percent in the area operated are noticed during this Census as against 2015-16 Census.

Institutional Holdings

- The Institutional holdings have a meagre part with 284 holdings with 0.004 percent of total number of holdings covering an area of 9209.10 hectares and is accounting for 0.15 percent of the total operated area.
- There's been a decrease of 56.04 percent in the number of holdings and an increase of 77.53 percent in the area operated when compared with the 2015-16 Census.

Chart 1: Number of holdings and area operated under all Agriculture Censuses from 1970-71 to 2021-22

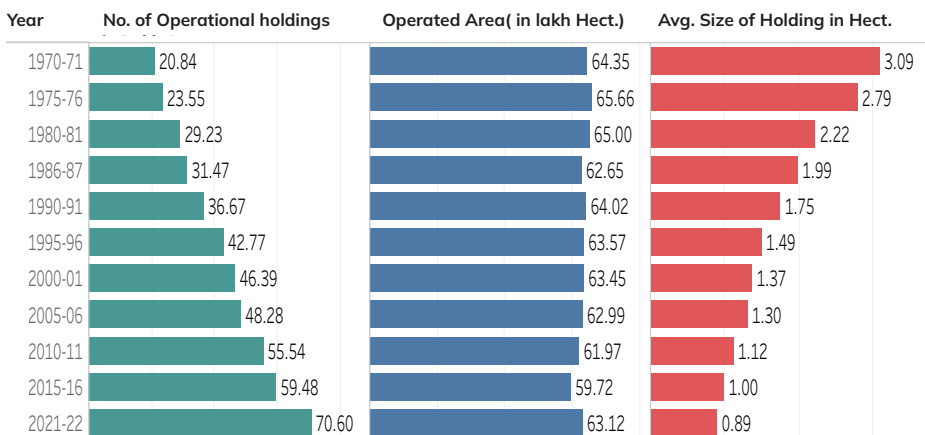
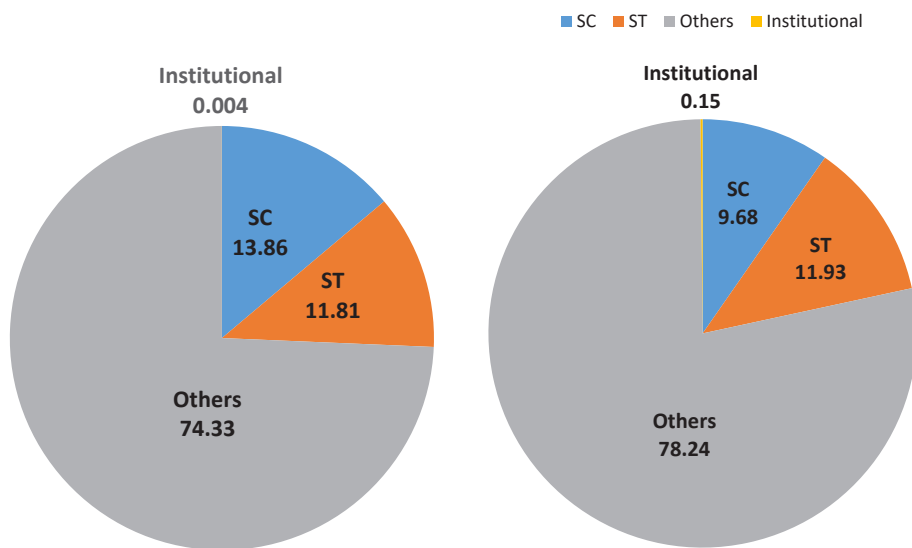


Chart 2: Percentage share of different social groups as per Agriculture Census 2021-22

The above table reveals that 68.65 percent of the total holdings belong to marginal group followed by small holdings (22.66 percent), semi-medium (7.15 percent), medium (1.40 percent) and large holdings (0.13 percent).

There is a decrease in the area of holdings in the semi-medium, medium categories by 11.55 and 20.50 percent respectively during the period 2015-16 to 2021-22 while in the case of marginal and small and Large categories there is an increase in the area by 21.16, 13.17 and 21.89 percent respectively. The area operated by the marginal and small holders put together accounted for 68.19 percent of the total operated area though they formed 91.31 percent of the total holdings in the state in 2021-22.

Chart 4.1: Number of land holdings (in lakhs)

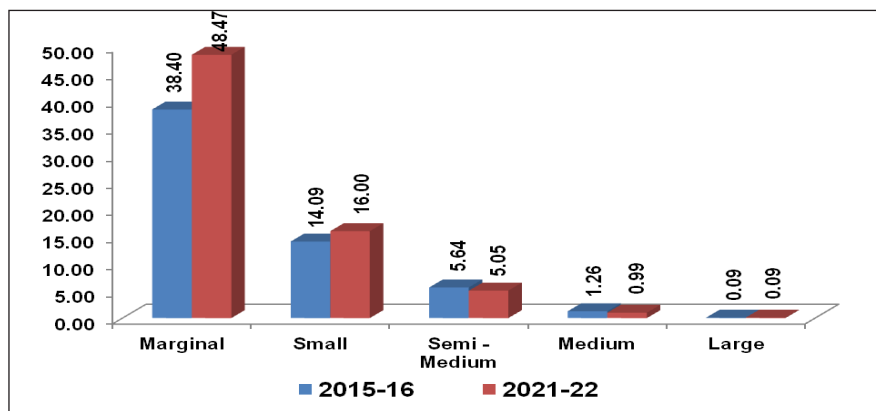
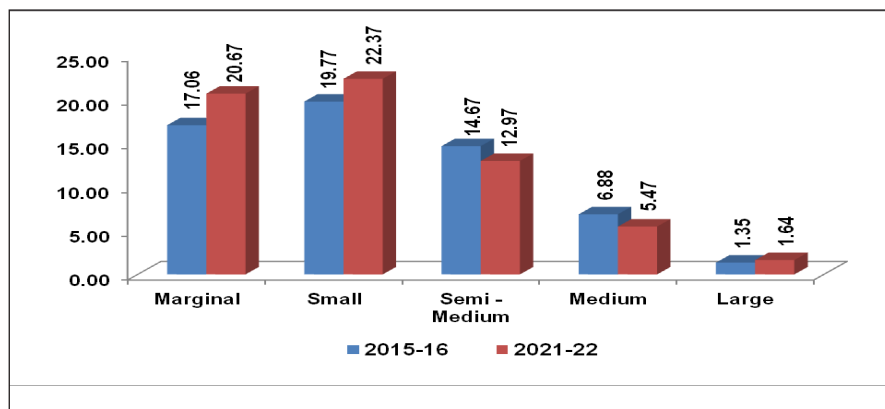


Chart 4.2: Area operated (in lakh hectares)



The average size of the holdings in the state was 1.00 hectare in 2015-16 and it declined to 0.89 hectares in 2021-22, which shows a negative percent of 10.59. The decrease in the average size of holdings is observed in Marginal, Small, Semi medium categories rest of categories shown as increased trend.

As seen from the above table, almost all holdings were individually operated as they constituted 99.99 percent of the total holdings and 99.85 percent of the total operated area. 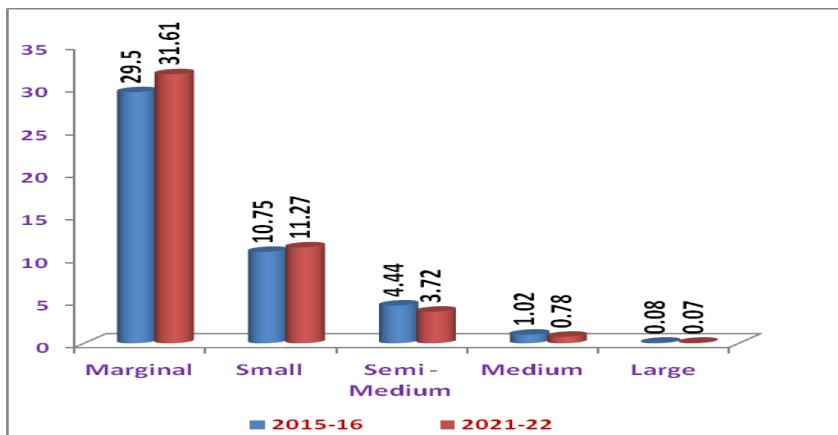

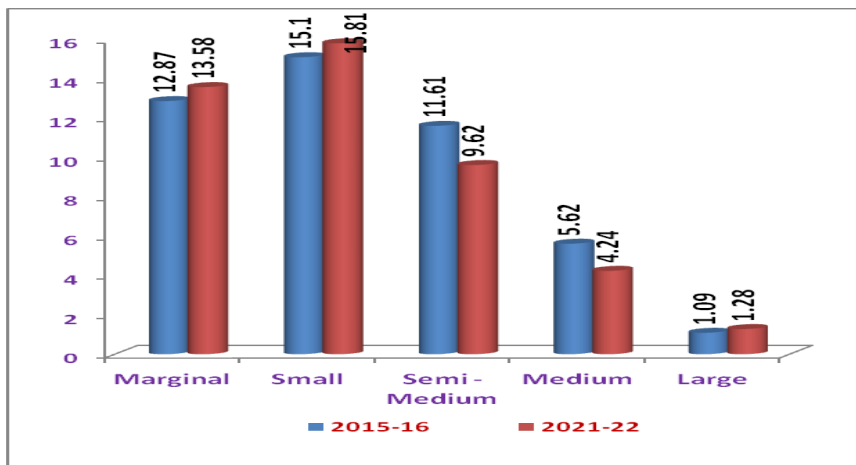
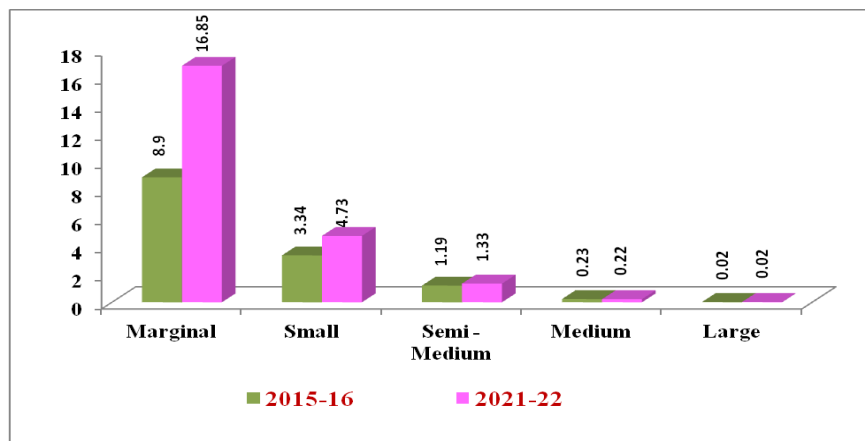

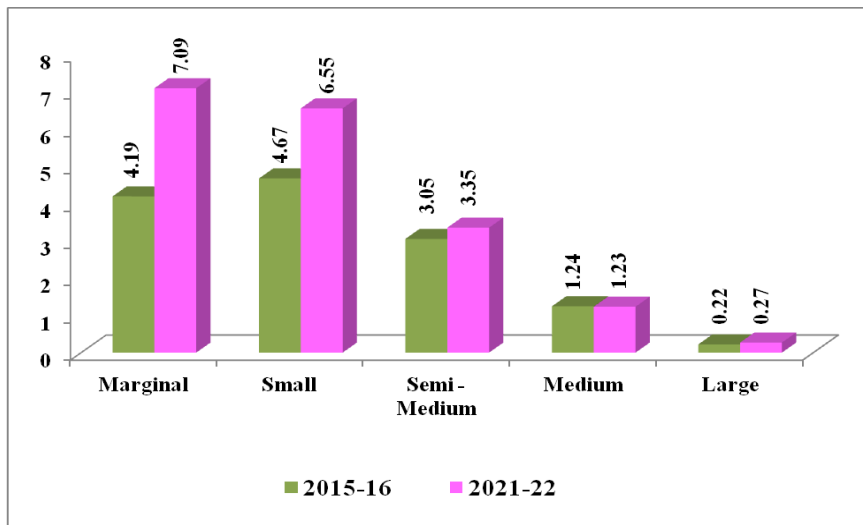

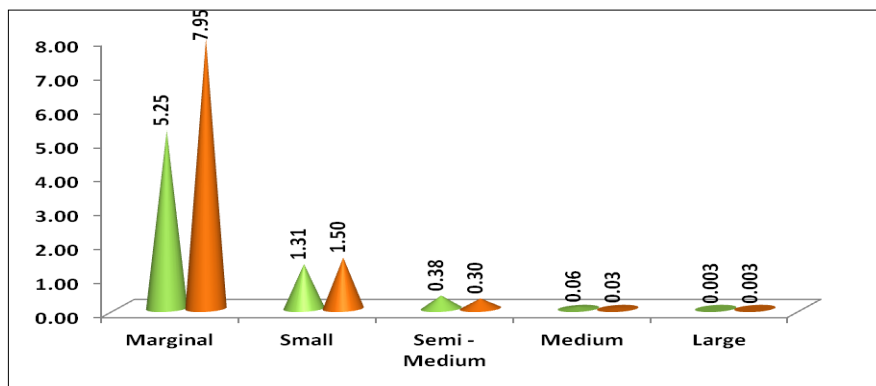

Comparison of Area operated by SC holdings in 2015-16 and 2021-22 Censuses (in lakh hectares)

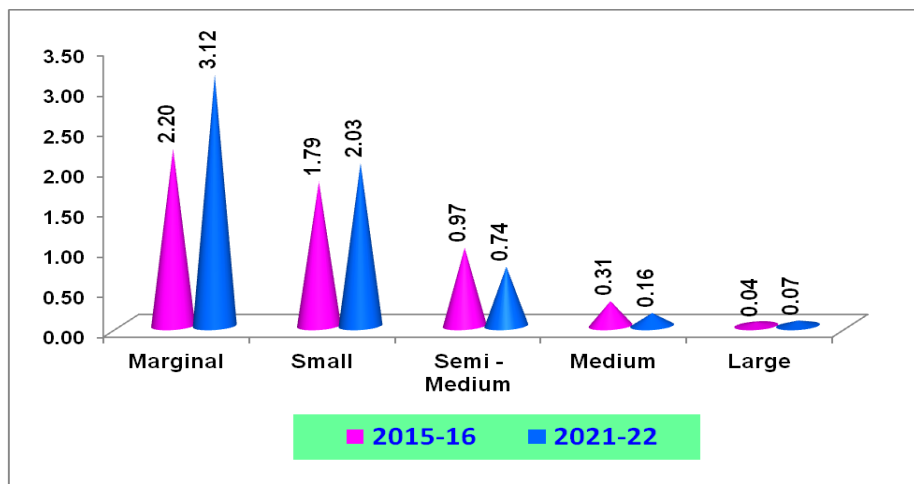

Comparison of ST holdings in 2015-16 and 2021-22 Censuses (in lakhs)

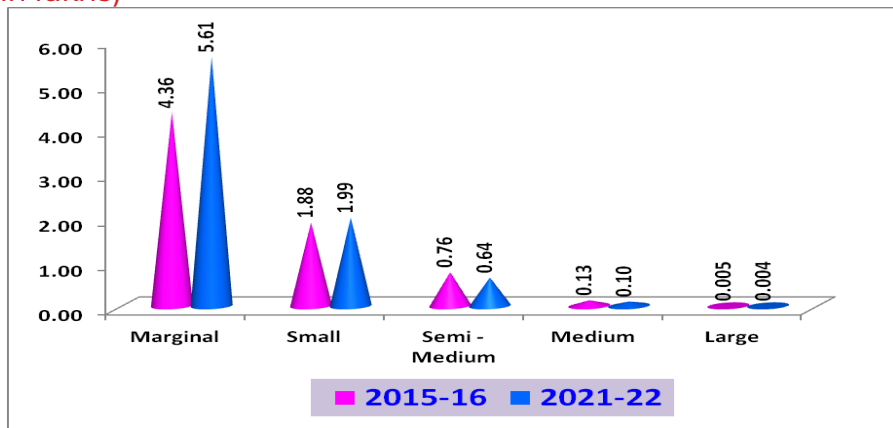

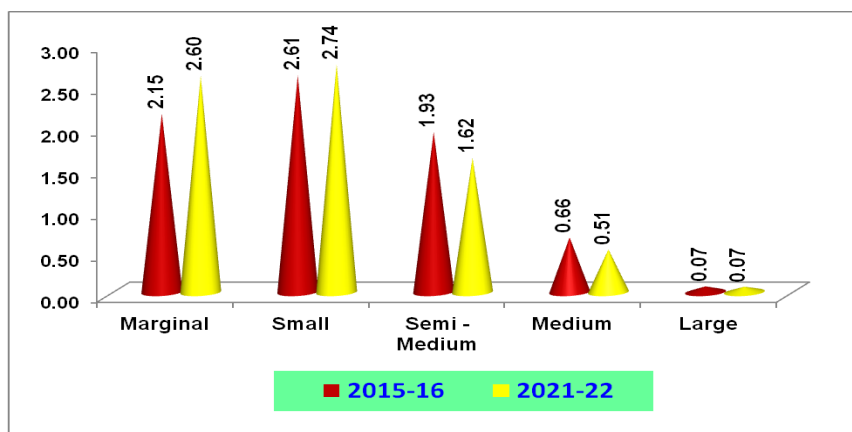

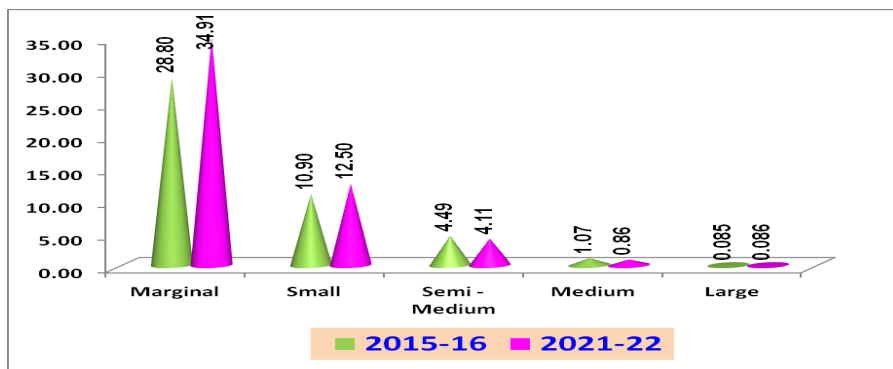
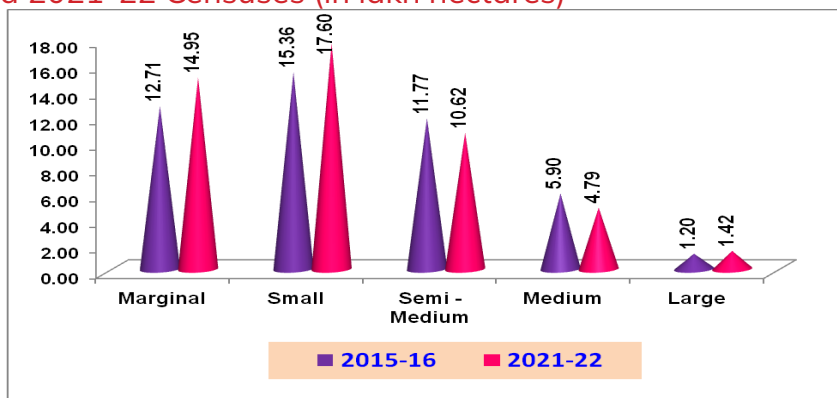

Comparison of Area operated by Institutional holdings in 2015-16 and 2021-22 Censuses (in hectares)

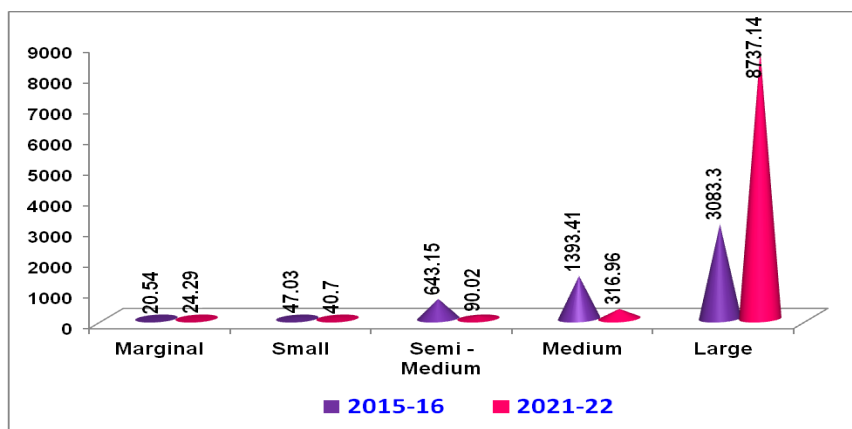


